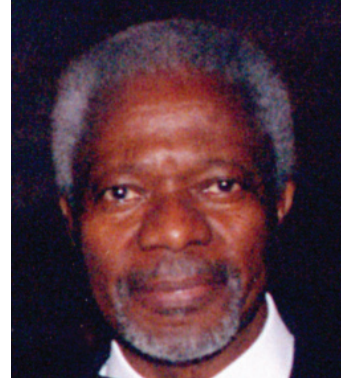


# 'In fighting anti-Semitism we fight for the future of all humanity'
