Dear Ms. Bachelet:

Senator Eugenio Tuma has recently made offensive anti-Semitic statements in recent interviews in the national media of Chile. We are writing to express our deep concern to you regarding these statements because Senator Tuma is reported to be the coordinator of your presidential campaign in La Araucanía.

For several years we have been troubled by the biased and anti-Semitic statements of Senator Eugenio Tuma. During your presidency, Senator Tuma, in support of Bill No. 686, vilified the State of Israel by comparing its actions to those of Hitler during the Holocaust. Last year, after the tragic ecological disaster in Torres del Paine Park, in Chilean Patagonia, Senator Tuma instigated a hateful firestorm accusing the State of Israel of being directly responsible for the unfortunate incident.

Senator Tuma's anti-Semitic outbursts bring shame upon him and have no place in the discourse of Chilean society. In his most recent statements given to Controversia TV and CNN Chile, he urged the public to read the anti-Semitic writings of the Chilean Nazi writer Miguel Serrano and he used these two platforms to spew hateful anti-Jewish and anti-Israel conspiracy theories.

You have been at the forefront of the efforts to safeguard freedom, justice and democracy in Chile and to champion an end to discrimination and all forms of hate.

The silence so far from civic, religious and political leaders in Chile is troubling. We are surprised that you have not yet spoken out to condemn forthrightly as unacceptable Senator Tuma's statements, which only incite to hate and discrimination and to make clear that his bigoted views have no place in your campaign to return to the Presidency of Chile.

With great respect, we urge you to publicly denounce Senator Tuma's statements and to make clear to the people of Chile that such views are not acceptable in your campaign or anyplace else in Chile.
